- Targets:** All bowstyles will shoot on Tenzone layered foam targets

- Judges:** Mr. Phil Collins, Mr Paul Richards & Mrs. Jane Cottee
- Registration:** Available from 08:00 each day. Please have AGB card available
- Kit Inspection:** Will take place each day prior to assembly
- Awards:** Trophies & medals will be awarded according to the number of archers competing in the category
- Entry Fees:** £15.00 per day or £28.00 for both days
- Event Timings:** Assembly 09:00 - Followed by 45 minutes practice - Shooting from 10:00
- Shooting Rules & Drug Testing:** The tournament will be shot to World Archery rules in force at the time. Archery GB dress regulations as shown in Rule 307 will apply. Archers competing at World Record events may be liable for drug testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply. Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result.
- Smoking:** Smoking (including the use of e-cigarettes) is only permitted in the car park. Please do not leave cigarette butts on the ground. Entry to this event is considered acceptance of this policy
- Refreshments:** A selection of hot and cold food and drinks will be available throughout the weekend
- Photography:** In line with AGB Policy, those wishing to take photographs during the weekend must register with the tournament organiser
- Camping:** Overnight camping is very limited and strictly by prior arrangement with the T.O.
